3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Biden Can't Force Me5 Act".

6 SEC. 2. PERSONAL BELIEF EXEMPTION FROM COVID-19 7 VACCINE MANDATES.

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Any COVID-19 vaccine mandate
9 issued by an Act of Congress or by an executive agency
10 shall include an exemption for any individual who has a

sincerely held belief that inclines the individual to refuse
 the receipt of a COVID-19 vaccine.

3 (b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

4 (1) COVID-19 VACCINE MANDATE.—The term
5 "COVID-19 vaccine mandate" means any require6 ment that an individual receive a COVID-19 vac7 cine, including any requirement that an employer re8 quire an employee or independent contractor to re9 ceive such a vaccine.

10 (2) EXECUTIVE AGENCY.—The term "executive
11 agency" has the meaning given such term in section
12 105 of title 5, United States Code.

(c) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in this section shall be construed to allow for or otherwise authorize
a COVID-19 vaccine mandate issued by an Act of Congress or by an executive agency.
